

**RULES GOVERNING THE SAFE OPERATION OF EQUIPMENT**

The following rules detail safe operational guidelines for the inflatable equipment you are leasing from “Jump Up Party Rentals”. To ensure safe operation of the inflatable, it is in your best interests to have these rules read aloud by a company representative to all persons delegated with the responsibility to use, operate, supervise, install, inflate, setup, deflate, clean, and/or deflate the leased equipment. It is further, recommended that all riders be informed of the safety operational guidelines prior to use. Further, you are encouraged to direct any questions you may have about the operation of the inflatable to your representative from Jump Up Party Rentals before you begin use of the equipment.

**Supervision:** The safety of the children depends on you. Your personal supervision is ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES. As the lessee of this inflatable unit, the safety of all the riders is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY. As the adult supervisor, you should position yourself in close proximity of the entrance to the ride and be prepared to assist riders when they enter/exit the ride, and shall prevent and discourage improper use or misuse by all persons. Moreover, the adult supervisor shall position himself/herself to be able to assess threats of hazardous conditions, including but not limited to, weather, spillage, proper working of inflatable and components, proximity to water, flames, heated devices, potential rubbing surfaces, and any or all other conditions that may compromise the health, safety, or welfare of any person, compromise the proper and safe operation of the equipment, or violate any provision of this agreement.

**Age Groups:** Only compatible age groups and sizes shall play on the inflatable at the same time. The following are guidelines as to the number of riders that may be on the inflatable unit at the same time:

BOUNCER--	SLIDE--
CHILDREN UP TO AGE 7: 8	MAXIMUM 2 PEOPLE OF
CHILDREN AGES 8 –12: 6-8	COMPARABLE WEIGHT,
INDIVIDUALS OVER 12: 4	HEIGHT, & SIZE

**Prohibited items: Shoes/Glasses/Jewelry, etc.:** All riders MUST REMOVE SHOES, GLASSES, ALL LOOSE JEWELRY, AND ANY AND ALL OBJECTS THAT MAY CONSTITUTE A HAZARD TO HEALTH, WELFARE, OR SAFETY OF ANY PERSON, OR COMPROMISE THE PROPER AND SAFE USE OF THE INFLATABLE before playing in the inflatable.

**Pre-existing Health Conditions:** Pregnant women, individuals with pre-existing injuries, and others susceptible to injury from falls, bumps or bouncing, whether known or unknown, ARE NOT PERMITTED IN OR ON THE INFLATABLE UNIT AT ANY TIME.

**Flipping/Wrestling/Piling:** Improper use of the inflatable includes, but is not limited to, flipping in the air, wrestling, and riders piling on themselves. Such activity may result in neck and back injuries to riders, and must be prevented and discouraged whenever possible

**Installation:** Do not remove the inflatable from the area where it was installed. If the inflatable unit moves, pull it by one of its corners back to its original location of installation. At all times, keep the inflatable unit away from hazardous or potentially hazardous conditions, including, but not limited to, swimming pools and other sources of water, open flames and other sources of heat, and from rubbing against surfaces

**Inclement Weather:** Once there is a threat of inclement weather, including strong winds (at or in excess of 20 mph), thunderstorms (especially when lightening is present), or severe cold weather (below 40 degrees), children should immediately exit the inflatable. The blower should thereafter be switched off and removed, and the unit allowed to deflate.

**Deflation:** Should the unit begin to deflate, do the following: First, have all children exit the unit immediately. Next, if the motor has stopped, make sure that it has not been unplugged. If the motor is still running, check the air intake on the side of the motor for blockage, and check both blower tubes on the inflatable unit to make sure that they are tightly tied off. NEVER ALLOW RIDERS IN OR ON A PARTIALLY INFLATED UNIT.

**Alterations:** NO ALTERATION IN OR ATTACHMENTS TO THE INFLATABLE UNIT ARE ALLOWED, PERIOD.

**General Misuse:** Do not allow riders to play or climb on walls, sides or roof of inflatable. Do not allow the inflatable rub up against any surface. Unless previously authorized by “Jump Up Party Rentals”, never place a water hose or water in general onto the inflatable. If the inflatable should become wet, discontinue riders from play, and have an adult wipe down unit before play is continued. However, when possible, have all riders exit inflatable while an adult wipes down unit and when dry permit riders to return. INFLATABLE SHOULD NOT BE WET WHEN RIDERS ENTER THE UNIT.

**Negligence or Abuse:** The following fees may be assessed for negligence or abuse of inflatable:

1. Spilled food, drink or the use of Silly String could result in a \$100-\$500 Cleaning Fee.
2. Negligence and/or damage to unit could result in a \$400-\$1000 Repair Fee.
3. If unit is not repairable a fee of \$1500-\$3000 could result.
